

TRI-FOLD BROCHURE MAKING CONTEST
2025 YOUTH SUMMIT FOR THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA

1. Theme

The brochure should focus on the West Philippine Sea, its value to the Philippines, the environmental, geopolitical, and cultural importance it has.

2. Message

Brochures should attempt to create awareness about the conservation of the West Philippine Sea, its resources, and the protection of marine biodiversity. As an alternative, they can concentrate on territorial sovereignty and the value of friendly negotiation in global conflicts.

3. Target Audience

Although the brochure should be made for a wide readership, students, young people, and the general public should be given special attention. All ages should be able to access, learn from, and enjoy the content.

4. Content Requirements

Highlighting marine biodiversity, ecosystem threats, pollution, or conservation efforts; discussing territorial disputes and their effects on the Philippines; examining the sea's role in Filipino culture, heritage, and local livelihoods; and providing ways for individuals to contribute to sea protection (e.g., reducing plastic waste, supporting marine conservation programs) are all examples of the brochure's visually appealing elements that showcase the West Philippine Sea's beauty without overpowering the content.

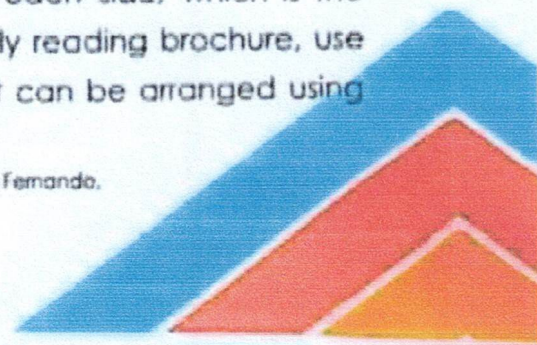
5. Design and Layout

When folded, the brochure must have three panels on each side, which is the traditional tri-fold format. For a visually beautiful and easily reading brochure, use readable typefaces and keep the layout simple. Content can be arranged using

bullet points, headings, and subheadings. Make use of colours that suggest a sense of nature and the water but keep the design from being overly cluttered or overpowering. The colour scheme should be in harmony.

6. Technical Specifications

Standard tri-fold size (A4 size).

7. Criteria for Judging

CRITERIA	DESCRIPTION	PERCENTAGE
1. Creativity	The brochure was exceptionally creative.	25%
2. Originality	The brochure presents itself in a unique and authentic manner.	10%
3. Content	The content of the brochure are accurate and relevant to the topic.	40%
4. Visual Impact	The brochure is visually engaging and well-designed. It attracts attention and has an impact on the reader.	15%

*Reaction of the participants to the West Philippine Sea brochure is 10%.
