
SUBJECT: **STATE OF THE DIVISION ADDRESS (SODA) CUM NATIONAL

PARTICULARS

1. Relative to Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4: Quality Education, targeted that by 2030, the Department shall ensure that all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development, including, among others, through education for sustainable development and sustainable lifestyles, human rights, gender equality, promotion of a culture of peace and non-violence, global citizenship and appreciation of cultural diversity and culture's contribution to sustainable development.
2. Thus, it is timely that the first State of the Division Address (SODA) be conducted to recognize partners/stakeholders and their laudable contribution to the realization of quality education in the Division.
